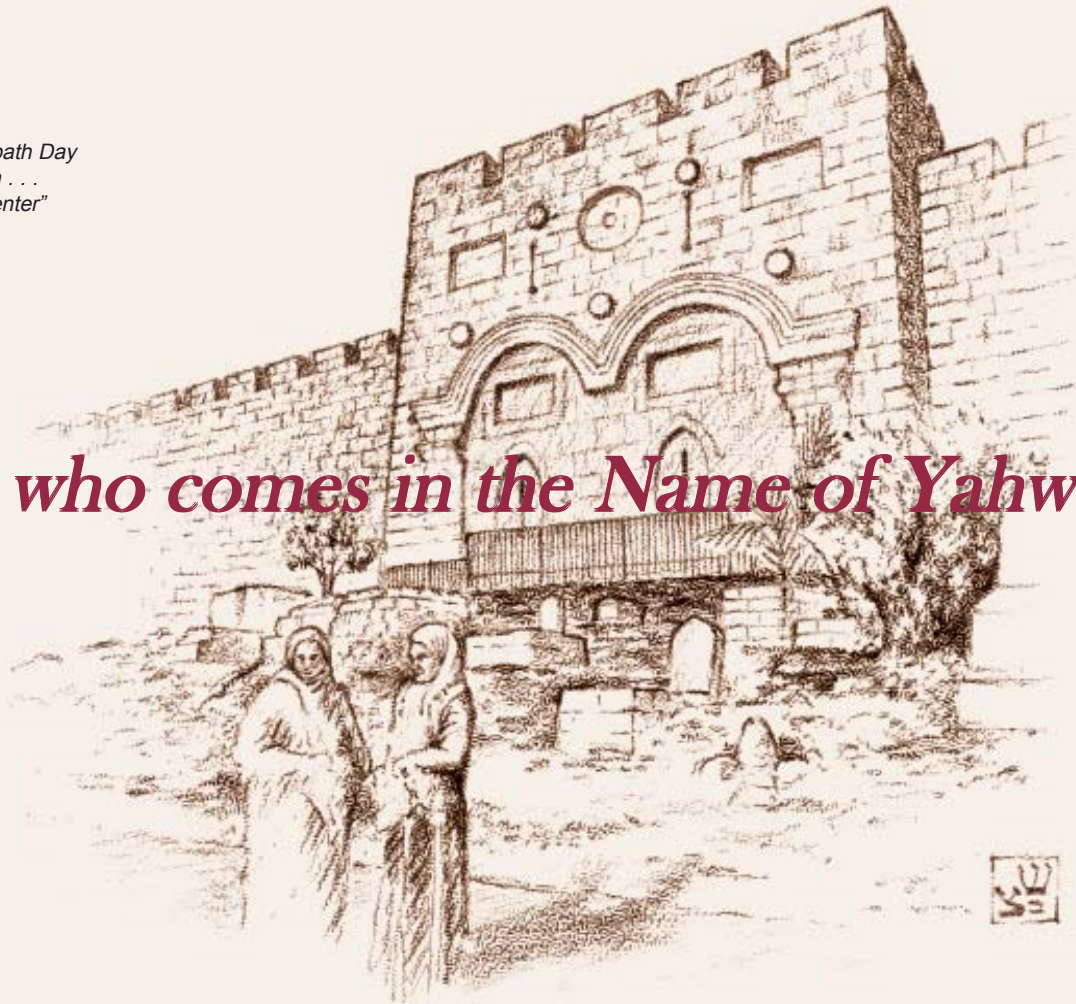

On Yom Teruah / the Day of Trumpeting, the archangel will shout "Tekiah Gedolah" - the Return of the Great One - before the Last Trump for the return of Messiah, and the resurrection of the righteous dead. We don't know the day or the hour, but we know the festival season.

On Yom haKippurim / the Day of the Atonements, two goats represent the two atonements - our sins being imputed to Yeshua and taken away, and His righteousness being imputed to us with the aroma ascending to heaven.

Hag Sukkot / the Feast of Tabernacles, is the Marriage Feast of the Lamb. It is also the time of the downfall of the nations; on the Eighth Day, all will become the one Kingdom of Messiah.
