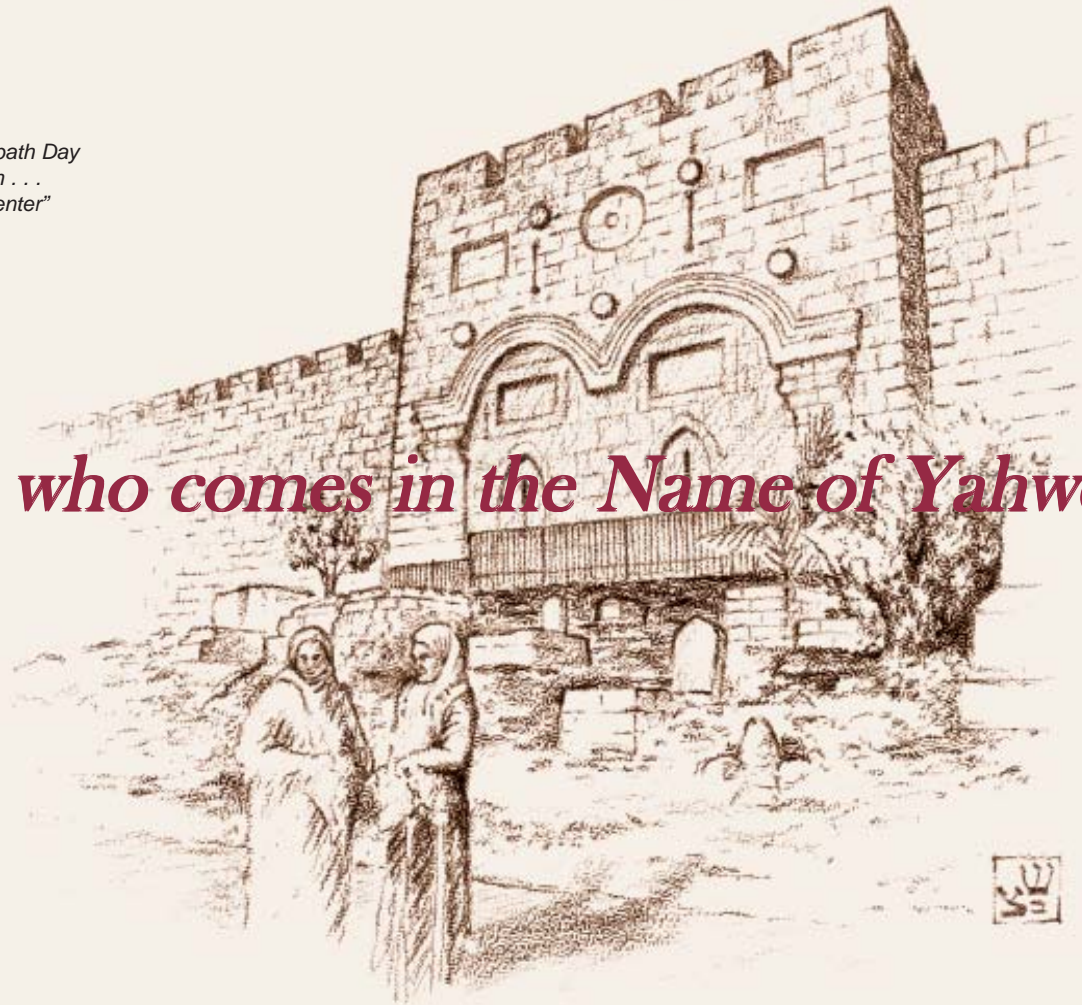

It requires preparation before the end of the sixth day. This ancient understanding has prophetic significance seen in Revelation.



On Yom haKippurim / the Day of the Atonements, two goats represent the two atonements - our sins being imputed to Yeshua and taken away, and His righteousness being imputed to us with the aroma ascending to heaven.






